PURPOSE

Moratorium Exceptions application materials have been published by the Minnesota Department of Health. Care centers interested in applying should prepare now to complete and submit all the required application materials by the December 20 deadline. This webinar will help care center staff evaluate whether to apply for a moratorium exception and provide an understanding of the new property rate system that will be applied to approved projects. It will also discuss options for implementing property projects outside the competitive process and reasons to consider that approach.
