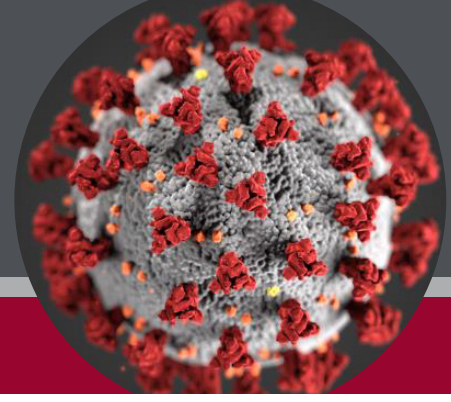


COVID Vaccine Mandates: Legal Considerations
