PURPOSE

Moratorium Exceptions Application Materials have been published by the Minnesota Department of Health and are due in December. Care centers interested in applying should prepare now to complete and submit all the required application materials by the December 20 deadline. MDH will review and publish a list of approved projects by April 4, 2019. This webinar will help care center staff evaluate whether to apply for a moratorium exception, provide an understanding of the various options for implementing property projects and the potential rate impacts of those options.
