

Preventing Diversion of Controlled Substances in Long-term Care

The pathway provides common sense interventions for each step in the controlled substance life cycle, from prescription to destruction and documentation – and includes education and investigation toolkits to simplify implementation.

- 1. Be able to verbalize trends from controlled substance investigations across Minnesota and understand areas of risk in long-term care.
- 2. Assess interventions in place at their homes against the new Controlled Substance Diversion Prevention pathway recommendations.
- 3. Identify "next steps" for reviewing the pathway with their team and implementing targeted interventions.
