- 4. Resolutions that are passed at the **Congressional District Convention** will then be forwarded to the **2024 State Convention** where they are voted on; where once again a simple majority is required to pass.
- 5. Resolutions that are passed at the 2024 State Convention are incorporated into the **Standing Platform** of the **Republican Party of Minnesota.**

## Attachment for MN GOP Caucus Resolution

- 75% of Minnesota Republicans agree that seniors have a right to basic housing, care, and support within 40 minutes of their home community.
- Nearly 4 in 5 Minnesotans worry that we are not prepared for the aging boom. We have 1 million people who are 65+ today, and over the next four years, we will have 50,000 more Minnesotans who are 80 or older.
