

TIPS FOR IMPROVING HAND HYGIENE AND PPE COMPLIANCE

Improvement in these base practices is needed to effectively combat COVID-19. Survey results show 36% non-compliance for hand washing; 25% non-compliance for PPE.

Tips to Bolster Compliance:

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Knowledge and	Ensure staff are comfortable with the detailed steps for donning and doffing
Comfort:	PPE; revisit periodically beyond initial training.
PPE	 <u>Sequence for Donning PPE Poster</u>
Donning/Doffing process	<u>Don and Doff PPE Video</u>
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Visual Reminders	Place posters in locations around the building
	Hand Washing Hygiene Poster
Positive	Recognize staff who are doing a good job of following hand hygiene or PPE
Reinforcement	Donning & Doffing steps. Be creative – something as simple as passing out
	lifesavers to staff "caught" following the process and reminding them how
	they are saving lives can be very effective.
Just-in-Time	Recruit staff members who can serve as Just-in-Time Coaches. This is not a
Coaches	"gotcha" approach but rather an opportunity to coach staff who are not
	demonstrating practices or proper technique. It is also an opportunity to
	gather information on any barriers for staff.
Share data with staff	Sharing data on compliance can create a sense of team – we are in this
	together. If you don't have your own data available, use the national survey
	data and challenge staff that we can do better!

Tips to Optimize Availability of PPE for Staff Use:

Reusing Masks	 Reuse face masks until they are visibly soiled or difficult to breathe through; Face masks should be carefully folded so that the outer surface is held inward and against itself to reduce contact with the outer surface during storage; Store folded face mask between uses in a clean, sealable paper bag or breathable container.
Reusing Gowns	Shift gown use towards cloth isolation gowns that are washable.
Reusing Eye Protection	 Shift eye protection supplies from disposable to re-usable devices (i.e., goggles and reusable face shields) Ensure appropriate cleaning and disinfection between users.
