



Long-Term Care Imperative Statement on Governor's Supplemental Budget

The following statement can be attributed to the Long-Term Care Imperative:

"Once again, the Governor is proposing cuts to Minnesota seniors. Whether it's fighting to ensure seniors can enjoy happy hour in their home or protecting them against cuts that threaten their access to care, we will not stop fighting for Minnesota's older adults. Simply put, cuts to long-term care are not only anti-family, they are deeply out of step with Minnesota's reality.

Governor Walz is the only Minnesota Governor to not invest in Minnesota seniors, families, and support long-term care providers, despite the fact that the number of seniors in the state is now greater than the number of K-12 students.
